**BUSINESS ARISING:** GHVBFB were successful in obtaining grant from Leeman Telecentre. This will be used to purchase 4 x UHF hand held radios and battery charger. Send letter of thanks

**GENERAL BUSINESS:**

Some comments have been received from the community, re Kenworthy's donation of time and funds, that there are more needy causes than the GHVBFB and that funds should have been given elsewhere. Geoff will address this issue at the next GH Community Association meeting, giving community members a better understanding of why funds need to be sourced from community.

Thank you letter to be sent to the Kenworthy's for their hard work.

GHVBFB are donating the use of the BBQ to the organisers of the Mt Leuseur excursion.

Letter has been drafted to go with community showbag drop. Julie to get bags.

ESL—The shire have allocated the five brigades that are within the Coorow Shire \$8,400. Operating costs such as maintenance and fuel are to come out of each allocation. Total of ESL funds for the Shire is \$42,000. This is a reduction of \$3000 from last years allocation due to a reduction in government expenditure. GHVBFB will purchase compressor, vacuum cleaner and blower vac with ESL funds.

DGR application has been submitted to the Tax department.

There has been no fire activity. A hazard reduction burn will be done behind the ambulance shed in Leeman, GH has been asked to provide some resources for this.

Western Power grant has been lodged.

Lotterywest grant lodged asking for GPS units for vehicles. Units will be map programmable
